Indent set-off quotations one inch from the left margin. Use any type of font that is easy to read, such as Times New Roman. Make ...

Use Times New Roman, twelve point font. Again, this is a basic rule for MLA format - probably the most basic, actually. If you mess up this part, your professor might not bother reading the rest of your paper. And if you dare to use Comic Sans, you'll be sorry. Indent after the first line of each entry (hanging indent) Entries are not numbered; Alphabetize by the first word of the entry. If no author is listed, begin with title. Italics must be used for titles of books and periodicals (If italics are used, the font must be obviously different from the standard print)

### **Basic MLA Rules - Citation Guide - Research Guides at ...**

Begin each source entry with the name of the author (s) or creator (s). The name of the first author is always inverted (last name, first name). When a source has two authors, the second author's name is shown in the normal order (first name, last name). Sources with three or more authors are shortened.

The Works Cited page should: Be at the end of your paper and be numbered consecutively with the rest of your paper. Include the words Works Cited centered at the top of the page. Include all sources paraphrased or quoted within you paper.
